

Wildcat Code of Conduct (For players, coaches, and fans)

Fundamentals of Good Sportsmanship

1. Know, understand and appreciate the rules of the contest.
2. Show respect for the officials. Good sportsmanship implies the willingness to accept and abide by the decisions of the officials. That includes not arguing or insulting the officials.
3. Show respect for the opponents at all times. Good sportsmanship is the Golden Rule in action.
4. Recognize and appreciate the skill of a performance regardless of team affiliation.
5. Maintain self control at all times. Good sportsmanship is a responsibility for all who are involved in the game. This includes players, coaches and fans.
6. Show a positive attitude in cheering, refraining from intimidation or negative cheering. Good sportsmanship is cheering your own team to victory.

Acts of Misconduct

1. Throwing of any object onto the playing field or in the stands.
2. Behavior deemed dangerous or behavior which interferes with the rights of others to observe the game.
3. Possessing, consuming or being under the influence of chemicals.
4. Use of obscene, profane or abusive language or gestures, signs, posters or banners which show disrespect for opponent's team, officials, cheerleaders, band or and other performing groups.
5. The use of noisemakers.
6. Entry onto the playing field at any time.
